- Napoleon may have called Britain "a nation of shopkeepers" but the honour of being a "nation of shops and shopping" rightfully belongs to Penang!
- Penang has always been a shoppers' paradise. During its freeport days, Malaysians made a beeline for the island in droves to shop for items like electrical goods, cosmetics and clothes. Shoppers never failed to leave the island without first loading their cars fully loaded with shopping bags.
- Although the freeport status was given to Langkawi in the 80s, Penang still remains a favourite shopping destination among locals and tourists. Hundreds of retail establishments are located strategically and conveniently in and around the city.

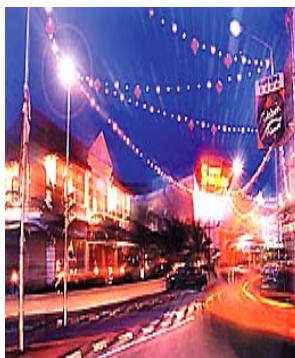

Shopping areas in George Town Penang:

- Lebuah Campbell: Chinese jewelers, Rolex watches, luggage's, clothes, electrical items and Chinese medicines and herbs
- Jalan Mesjid Kapitan Keling: Indian jewelers, money changers and florists
- Chulia Street: Clothes, antiques, framed art and glass items
- Bishop Street: Imported clothes, carpets, antiques and banks
- Penang Road: The entire stretch of Penang Road is lined with shops selling clothes, shoes, imitation perfumes and edible favorites

Remember that bargaining involves offers and counter-offers, so be patient and slowly work the price down to something both you and shopkeeper are happy with.

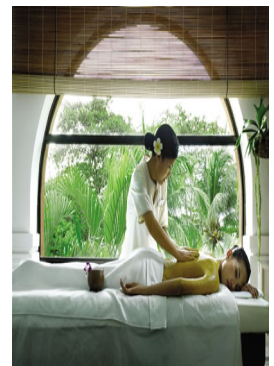

Famous areas in Kuala Lumpur for shopping include:

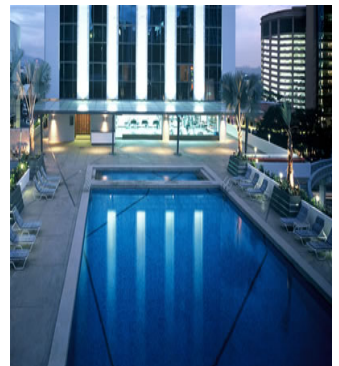
- Petaling Street: Chinatown Zone
